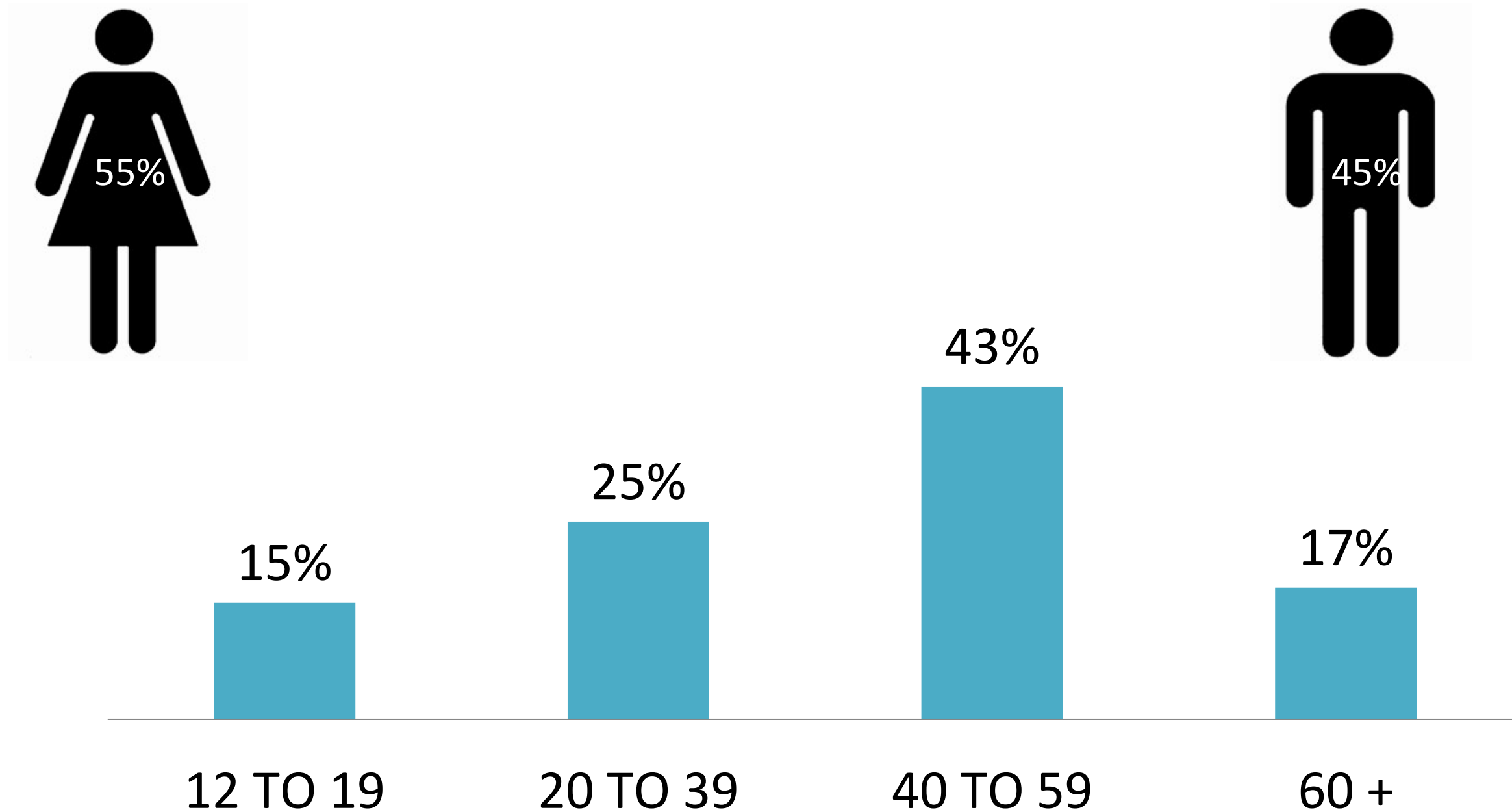
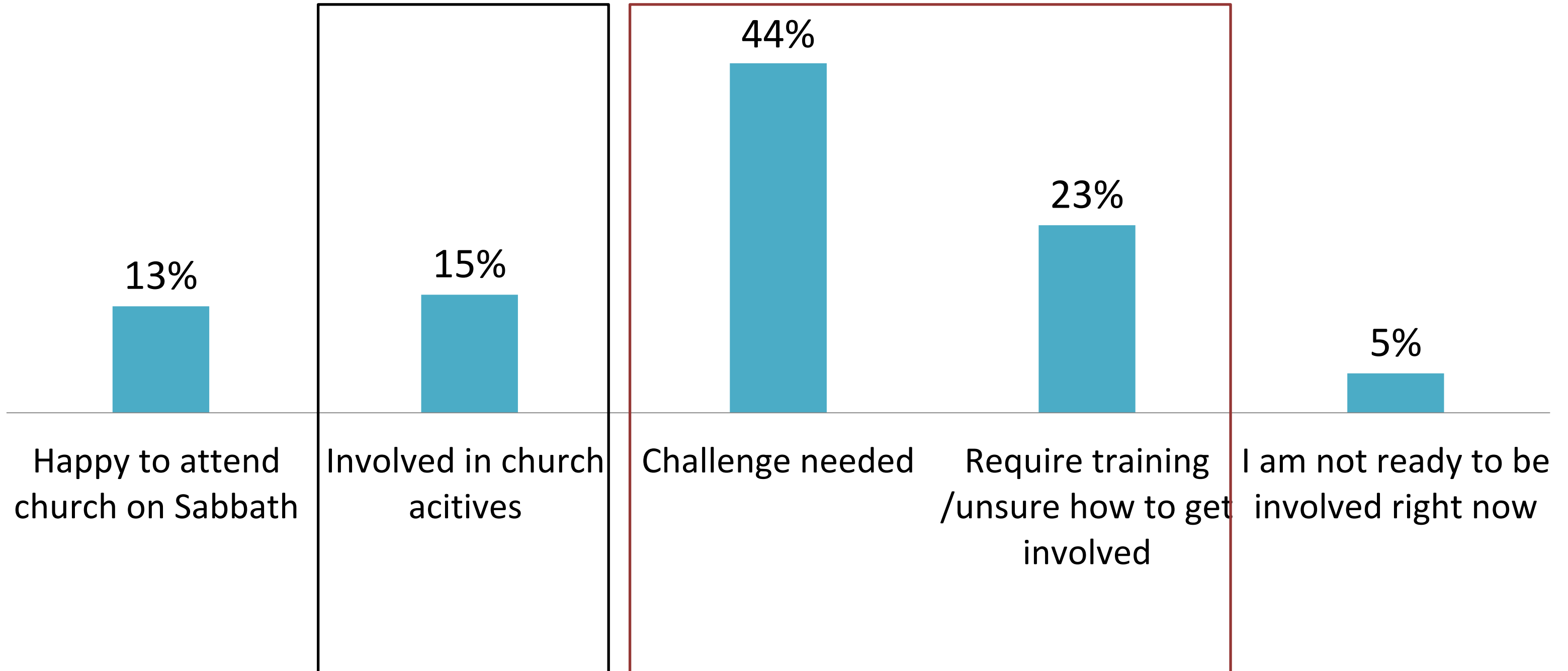

## Level of Engagement

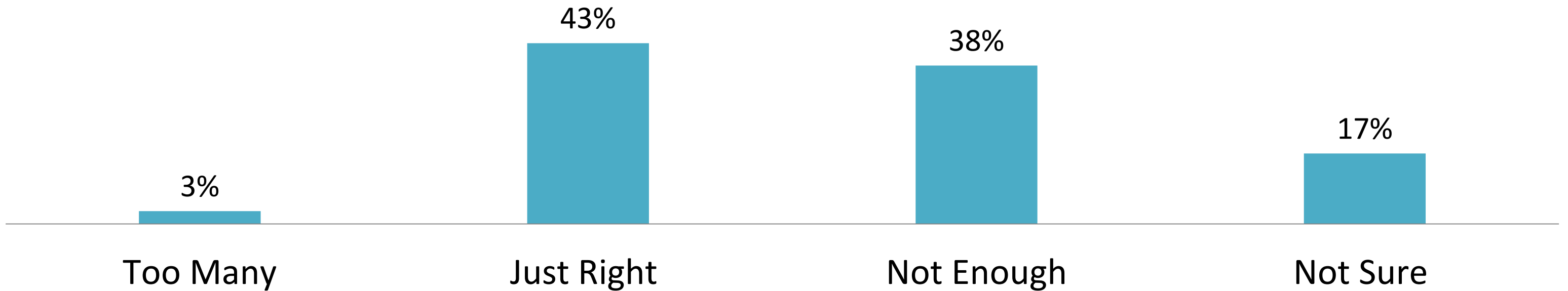


- ✓ 15% of respondents felt that they were actively engaged in church activities while almost 70% are willing to become engaged if the right opportunity or training is provided
- ✓ Youth and non members are not currently involved in church activities but would consider becoming involved if training and mentorship was offered
- ✓ **How can I take what I'm good at (my talents) and apply them to the church?**

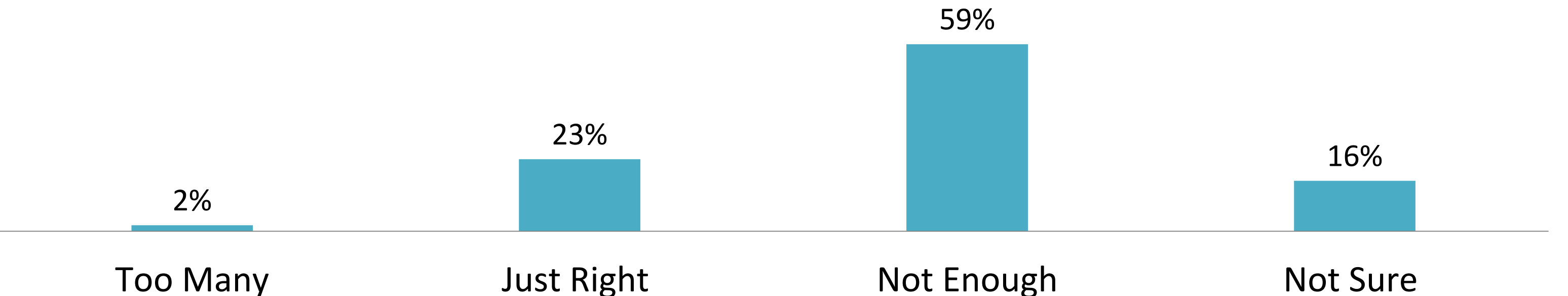

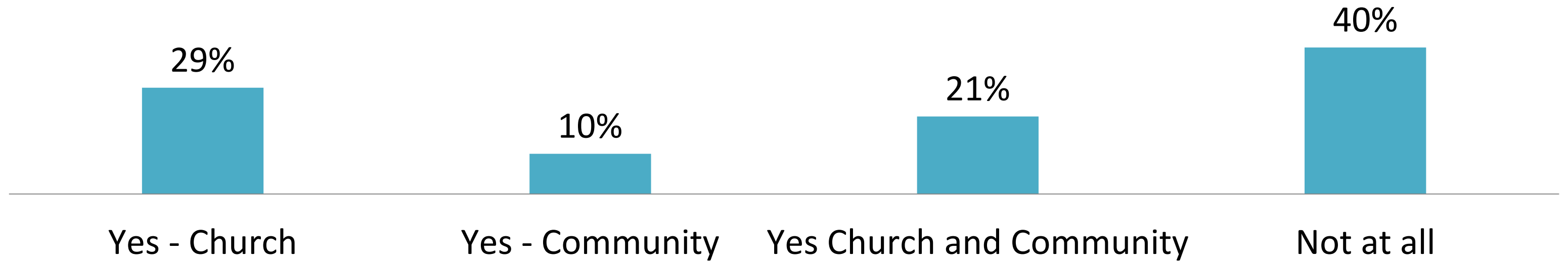
## Commentary

- ✓ **How can I grow spiritually through the programs currently offered at church?**

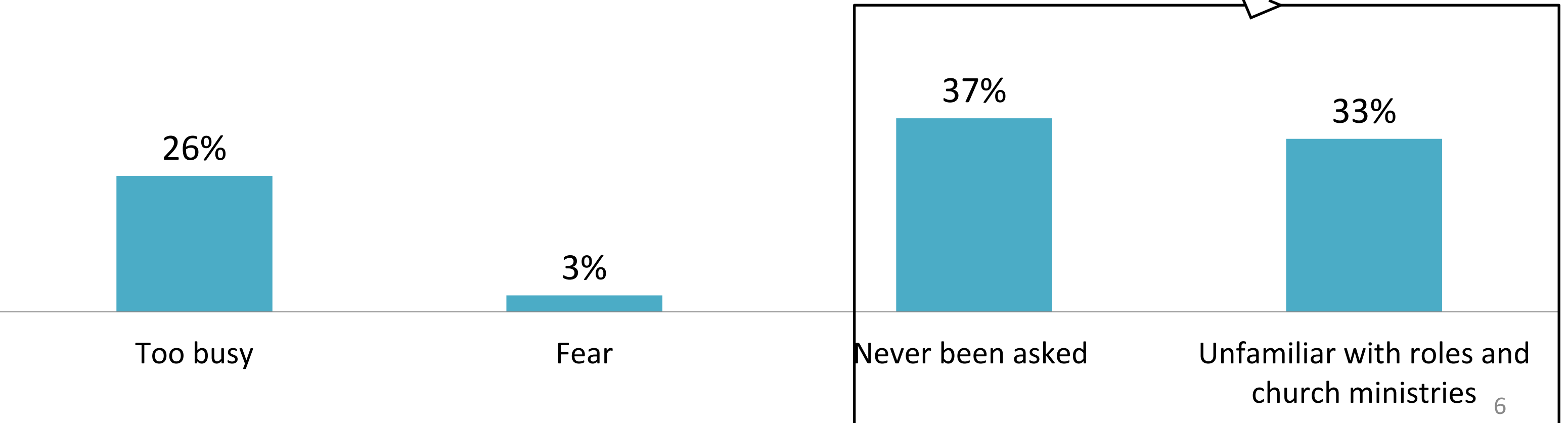

**4. If not, why not?**

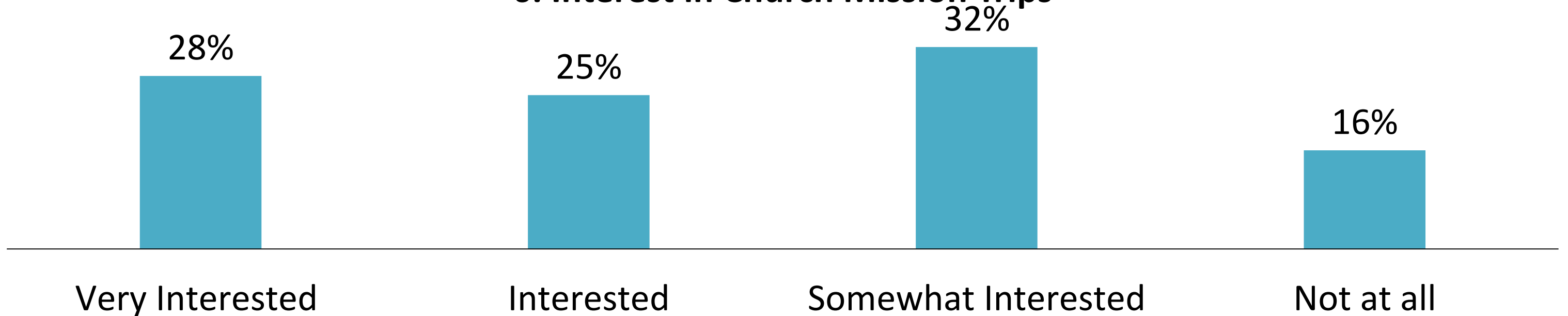


- ✓ **40% of respondents not currently involved for the following reasons:**
  - Never been asked – respondents desire a “personal touch”
  - Unfamiliar – respondents want to know more about:
    - ❖ Prison ministry
    - ❖ Mustard seed
    - ❖ Leadership development
- ✓ **Respondents believe that in-reach could be improved by:**
  - Creating activities to develop a sense of community that will engage youth, young adults and new members after church
  - Developing youth mentoring and training opportunities
  - Empowering elders and deacons to lead more initiatives
  - Linking sermons to end time events
  - Inviting guest speakers / conducting revival meetings
- ✓ Respondents that were fearful were primarily youth and non members
- ✓ **Am I willing to take a step in faith?**

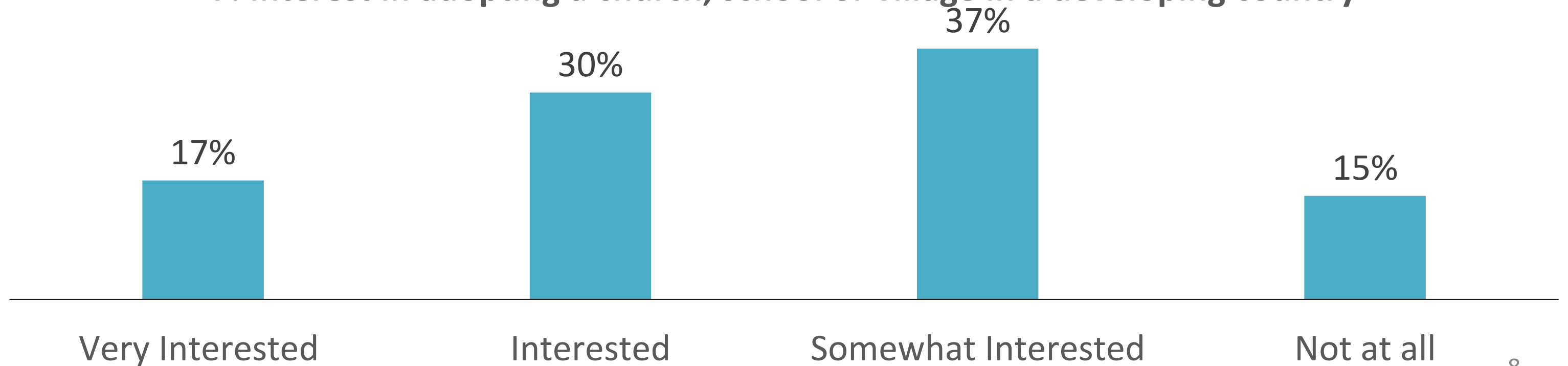

### 7. Interest in adopting a church, school or village in a developing country



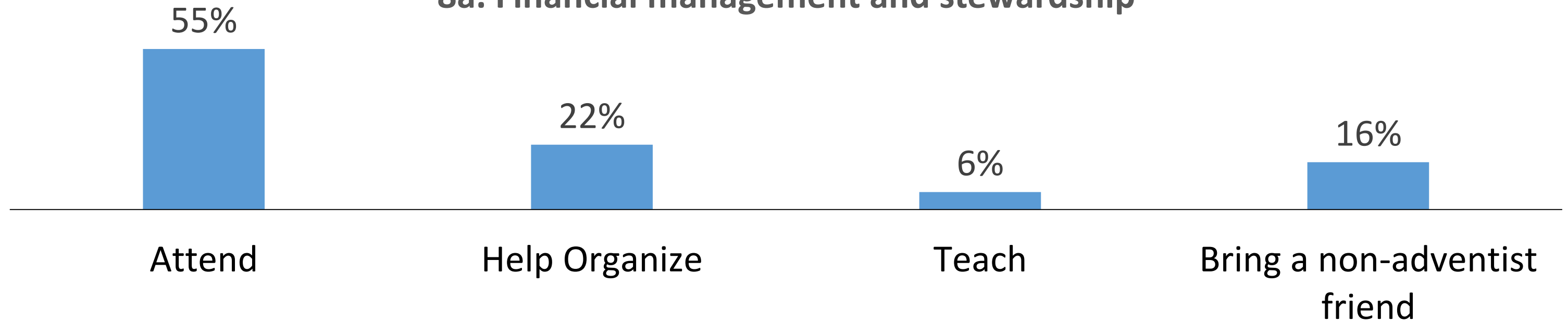


- ✓ **Over 80% of the church expressed interest in global outreach**

- ✓ **Which outreach program would excite or challenge me and how do I get involved?**

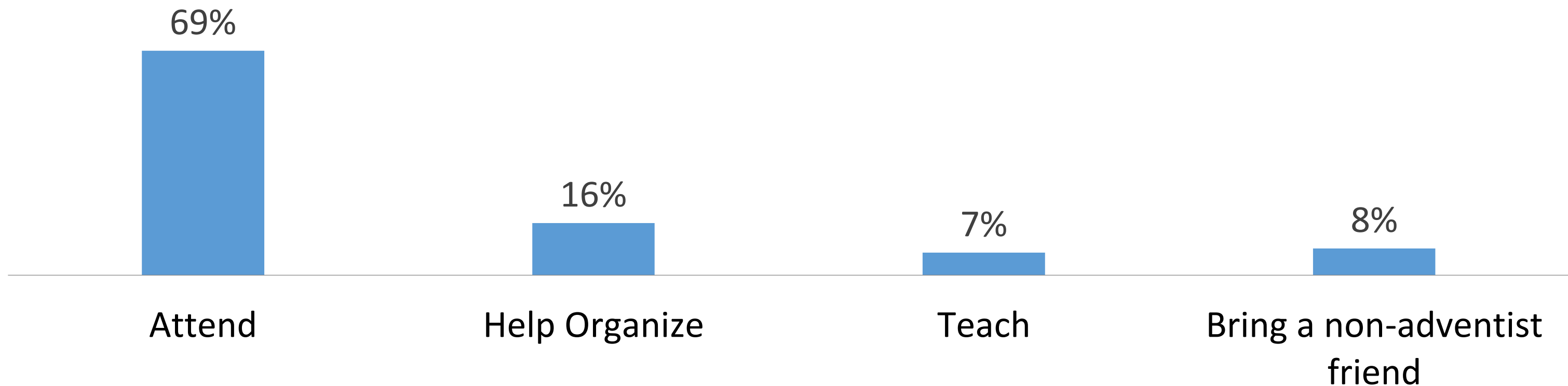

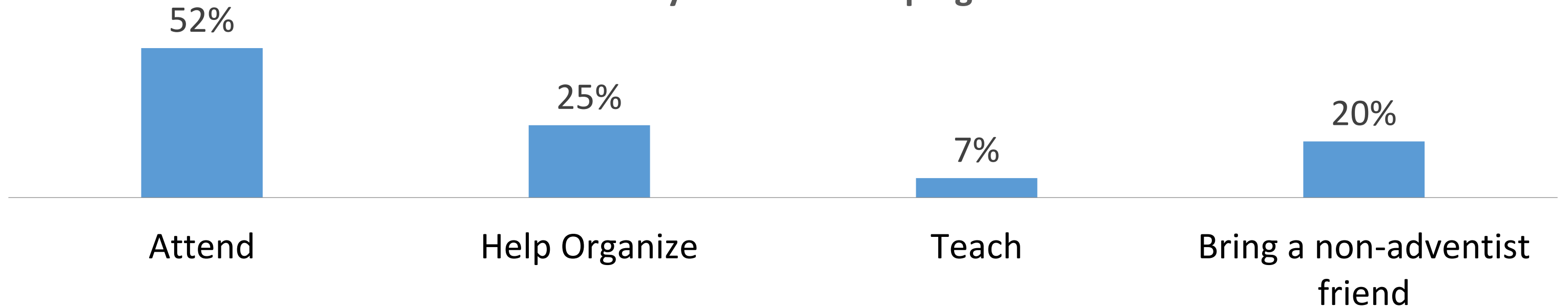

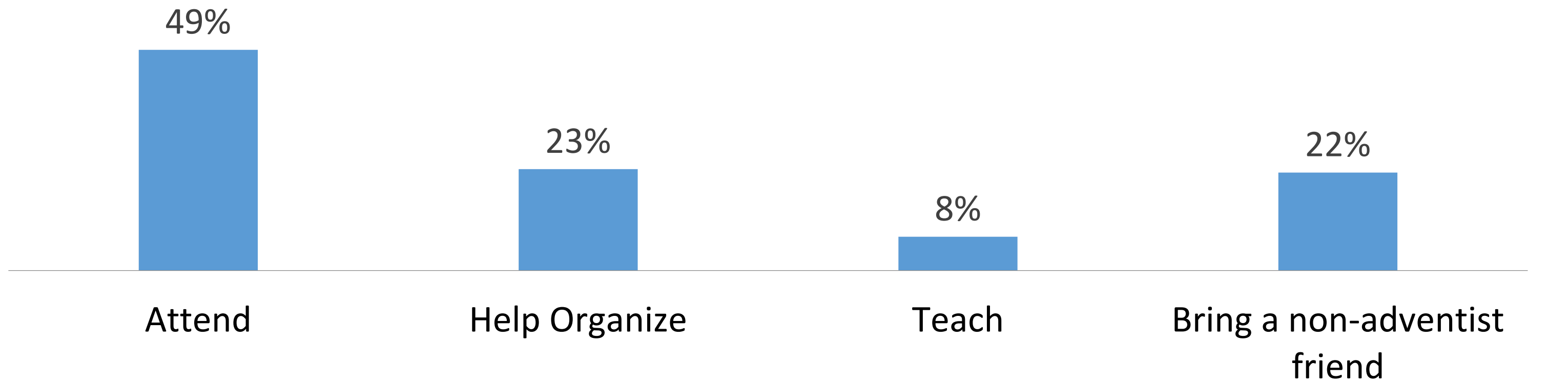

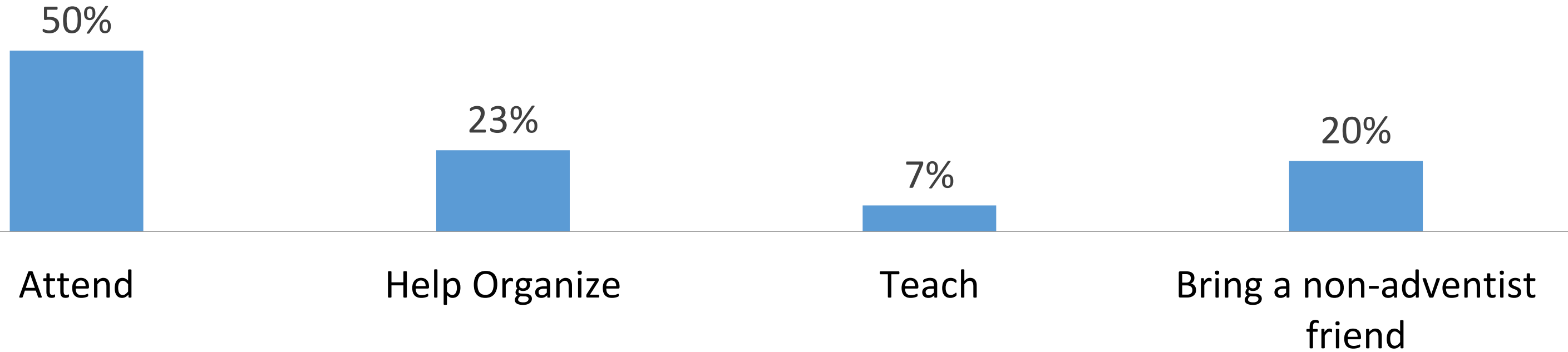

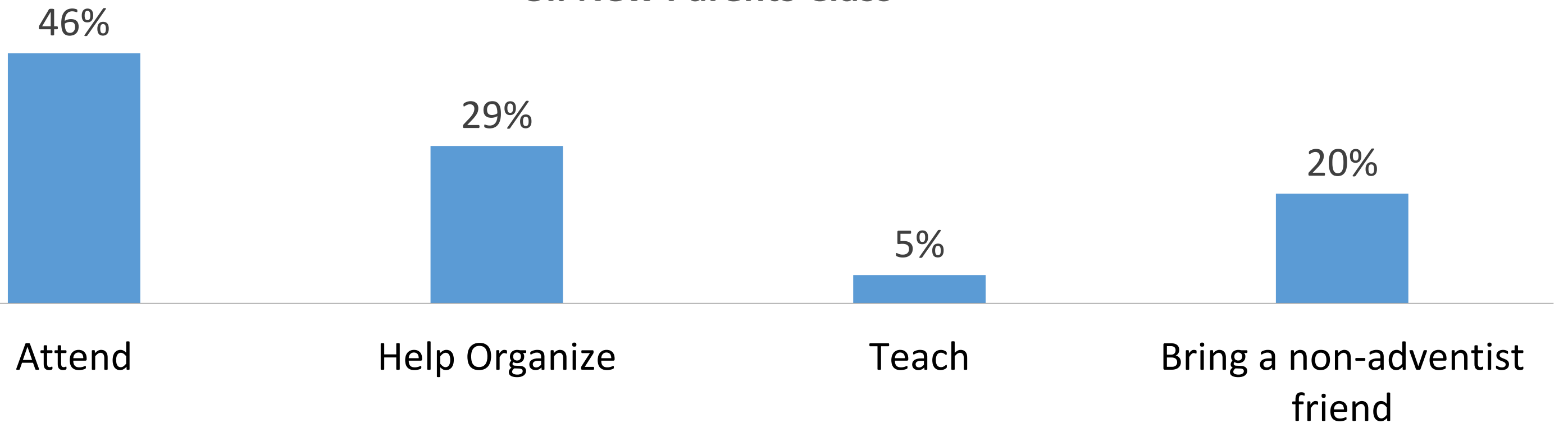

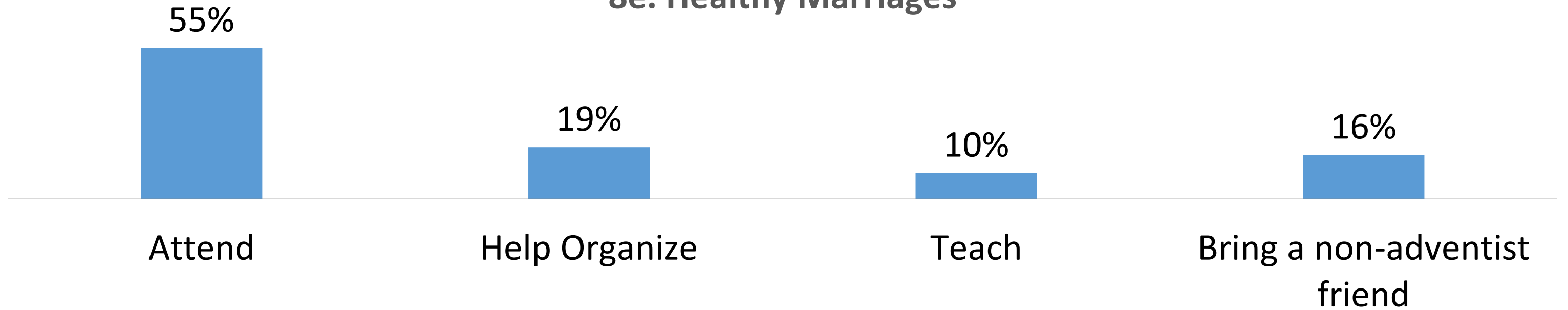

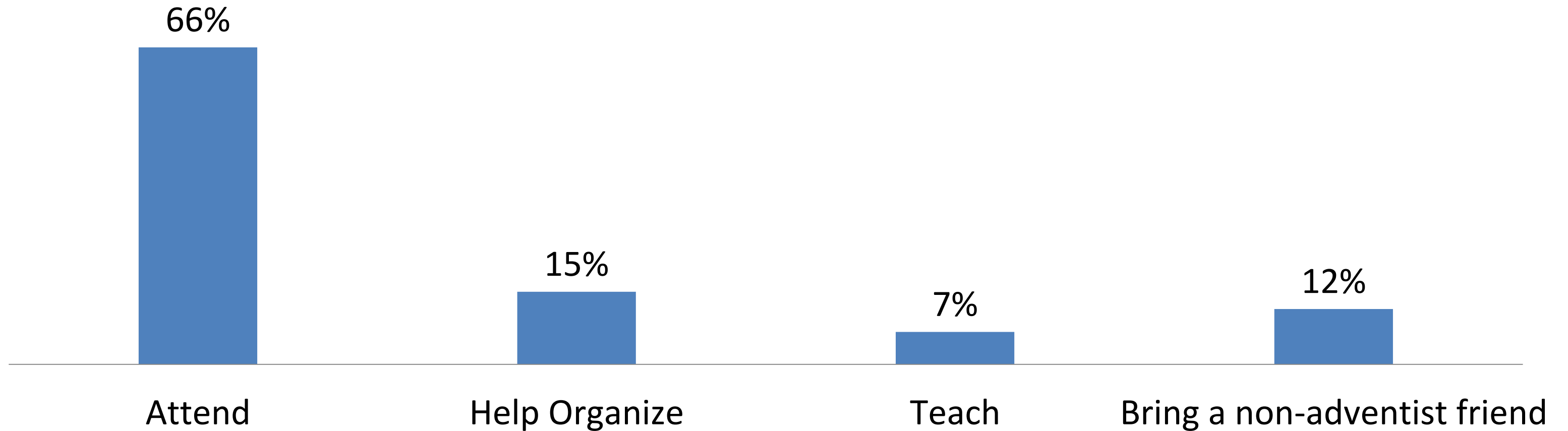
